National Treasures in CUHK: Rare Rubbings of the Song Dynasty donated by Bei Shan Tang

Venue: Gallery III, Art Museum, The Chinese University of Hong Kong

Period: 23 September – 28 December 2025

The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) holds the distinction of being Hong Kong's sole institution with collections inscribed in China's "National Catalogue of Precious Ancient Books" (國家珍貴古籍名錄). Its holdings represent the most preeminent assemblage of such cultural treasures among local higher education institutions.

Following the resounding success of the 2023 exhibition "Rare Rubbings of the Song Dynasty" (宋拓魅力:碑帖珍本特展), co-organised by CUHK and the Palace Museum, Beijing, the CUHK Art Museum proudly presents this new special exhibition. Featuring 20 national treasure-class Song dynasty rubbings from the Bei Shan Tang collection, alongside more than 12 masterpieces of calligraphy and painting spanning the Yuan to Qing dynasties, the exhibition illuminates how these delicate ink impressions inspired generations of literati, shaping Chinese calligraphic traditions through seven centuries of artistic conversation—from antiquity to imperial China's final golden age.

Echoing this theme, the exhibition bridges tradition and technology by integrating classical artefacts with videos and 3D-printed reproductions. These multimedia creations vividly animate the historical and cultural significance of stelae inscriptions, model calligraphies, and their ink rubbings, revealing new dimensions of these timeless treasures. Forged through collaboration between CUHK Library's Learning Garden, the Audio-Visual Division, and student interns, this exhibition employs technology and dynamic narrative techniques to create immersive, accessible encounters with the ancient art of Chinese rubbings, offering transformative experiences for audiences across the Greater Bay Area.

An English catalogue will debut at the opening ceremony, featuring the congratulatory messages by Vice-Chancellor Professor Y. M. Dennis Lo and Bei Shan Tang Foundation Chairman Dr Chien Lee. The publication embodies CUHK's vision to "combine tradition with modernity, and to bring together China and the West"—a mission dedicated to sharing China's cultural heritage with the world.
